### INSTALLING LUTS

#### Installing LUTs in Premiere Pro

Start by importing your videos or open a recent project. Once you have your clips ready to go, navigate to the Color Tab and look for Basic Correction.

In the Basic Correction section, you'll see a button titled 'Input LUT' with the clickable word 'None' next to it. Click this button and then click Browse.

Clicking 'Browse' will open up your folders. Navigate to the desired LUT you downloaded to apply it to your clip. Once applied, you can see the effects of the LUT on your footage.

You'll also see the color waveforms change in your Lumetri Scopes tab to give you an idea of how the LUT affects your clip.

From here you can adjust the White Balance, Tone, Highlights/Shadows, and more to get your clip just right.

Alternatively, it can be good practice to apply your LUTs onto adjustment layers, rather than directly on to the footage clips themselves.

#### Installing LUTs in After Effects

Again, to import a LUT in After Effects you'll need some footage that you can apply it to. Start by importing your clips and organizing your composition.

Once you have your clips in the composition, you'll need to find the Effects & Presets Panel. If you don't see it within your workspace you can find it by clicking Window > Effects & Presets.

The panel will then show up in your workspace allowing you to search for specific effects/presets that you can apply to your layers.

Now that you have the Effects & Presets panel open, all you have to do is search for 'LUT' or 'apply color LUT' specifically to find the utility you'll use to apply LUTs in After Effects.

Click and drag the utility onto your clip and it will open your documents where you can search for the specific Jay Color LUT you'd like to apply to your footage.

After you select a LUT, it will be applied to the clip that you added the Utility preset to. You can view the Effect Controls in the top left of your workspace where you can reset the LUT and/or choose a different LUT for your clip if you're going for a different look.

Again, it can be good practice to apply your LUTs onto adjustment layers, rather than directly on to the footage clips themselves.

### Installing LUTs in Final Cut Pro

Open the 'Effects' Browser and click the 'Color' tab Next, drag and drop the 'Custom LUT' Plugin to your footage. Then you can simply import your LUT. Again, you may need to adjust the White Balance, Tone, Highlights/Shadows, and more to get your clip to look perfect.

## **INSTALLING PRESETS**

### Installing Presets in Lightroom Classic (version 7.3+)

Open Lightroom Classic and go to the Develop module. You will see the modules listed at the top, right. You will be in the Library module when the program is first opened.

On the left you will see a section called Presets. You will see that there are already some basic presets listed. These come bundled with Lightroom.

Click on the + icon at the top right of the section. Select Import Presets from the dropdown menu.

Navigate to where you've saved your Jay Color Presets, select the desired files and click Import.

Your presets will now be listed in the Presets section.

## Installing Presets in Lightroom Classic (version 7.2 or older)

Open Lightroom and click on Preferences and go to the Presets tab.

Click on the button Show Lightroom Presets Folder.

Double click on the Lightroom folder, then double click on Develop Presets folder.

Navigate to the where you have saved your Jay Color Presets and copy the desired folders into the Develop Presets folder.

Restart Lightroom and you're done!

## Installing Presets in Lightroom CC

Open Adobe Lightroom CC 2018

Navigate to left sidebar and find "Presets" tab.

Click the "+" icon.

Select "Import Preset".

Navigate to and select your desired Jay Color preset files.

## Installing Presets in Lightroom Mobile

To access your presets on the Lightroom mobile app, simply follow the above tutorial to install the desired presets into your Lightroom desktop application. The presets will then sync with your Adobe cloud account and become available to use in the presets section of your Lightroom mobile app almost instantly.
