HOW TO INSTALL THE PRESETS

To install presets for Lightroom Classic CC:

1. Open the "Preferences" panel,
2. Move to the "Presets" tab and click on the "Show Lightroom presets folder" button.
3. A new Finder (Mac) or Windows Explorer (Windows) window will open
4. Find the "Develop Presets" folder
5. Move the folder with my Presets for Lightroom Classic CC here
6. Restart Lightroom

In this way you will find your new filters in the left panel, in the "Development" module.

To include presets for Adobe Camera Raw, copy and paste all the files in the "Preset Adobe Camera Raw" within the following folder:

- on Mac Library > Application Support > Adobe > Camera Raw > Settings
 - on Windows C: \ Users \ Your_Name_Utene \ AppData \ Roaming \ Adobe \ CameraRaw \ Settings
- If you can't find the AppData folder, turn on the display of hidden items.

To have the lightroom presets on your phone follow the following steps:

- Go to the app store and download "Adobe Lightroom CC"
- Create a folder called "Presets"
- Download them to your computer and then send them to your mobile phone or download them directly from your phone.
- If you managed to open the presets directly on Lightroom you will find them here, otherwise add presets directly from the app with the blue button at the bottom left with the + sign, will appear in your black photos with the writing DNG. Add them to the "Presets" folder, previously created.
- To edit your photos you only need:
 1. go to your "Presets" folder and click on the top three dots and go to "copy the settings" of the photo / preset that seems most suitable to you,
 2. Open the photo you want to edit and click on "paste settings" in the photo you want to edit, always through the three dots at the top right.
