

## **How to install fonts:**

### **Mac:**

Once downloaded double-click to unzip the file. Then double-click on the OTF font in the Finder, then click Install Font in the font preview window that opens. After your Mac validates the font and opens the Font Book app, the font is installed and available for use on all programs that type.

### **PC:**

Unzip the folder containing the fonts first.  
Fonts cannot be installed if they are zipped.  
Right click on the OTF font file and select Install.  
The font is installed and available for use on all programs that type.

### **Canva:**

Open your project  
Select your text area  
Click the font dropdown  
Click "Upload a font" at the bottom of the list  
Click "Upload a new font" from your brand kit page  
Select your font (make sure it's the font file and not the zipped folder)

## **How Ligatures Work:**

Ligatures are :  
Two or more letters are joined together to form one glyph or character.  
They are automatic, and will join when typed. If this does not happen then you ligature setting is turned off in your design software . Every software is different so google how to turn ligatures on in your specific software. For Adobe software. It is in the open type panel.

Canva does not support ligatures at this moment. Many font designers have lobbied Canva to include this basic feature that most other software has had for decades but no luck at this stage.

### **Other font files:**

All fonts come with web font versions like Woff and Woff2 to be used on websites.
