# HOW TO INSTALL YOUR PRESETS

## FIND THE FOLDER

1. Windows Users: Open Lightroom Classic CC > Go to the Edit dropdown > click on Preferences.
2. Then, click on the Presets tab > click on Show Lightroom Develop Presets

## PASTE YOUR PRESETS

1. PLACE YOUR PRESETS IN THE CAMERA RAW > SETTINGS FOLDER.

## RE - OPEN

When you re-open Lightroom, your presets will be installed.

## **Open Adobe Lightroom CC (desktop).**

1. Select File > Load Presets & Profiles.
2. Navigate to the individual folders you unzipped and saved on your computer. Select the presets and/or profiles you want to import.

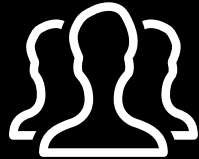
## **RE - OPEN**

1. If you do not see your preset or profile folders Restart Lightroom CC. If you still have trouble visit our Support page for other install instructions.

## **SYNC - SETTING**

Be sure your sync settings are turned on for desktop and your mobile app. Presets will sync to your mobile device.



## **Why is the presets formatted as XMP instead of Irtemplate?**

Beginning with Lightroom CC 1.3 and Lightroom Classic 7.3, Adobe Lightroom imports and converts your Irtemplate files into xmp format which is compatible with Adobe Camera Raw in Adobe Photoshop.

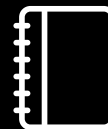
